



Privacy Policy for Greety App

Effective Date: June 2, 2026

Thank you for choosing Greety, an app designed to help users keep track of their contacts' birthdays and send personalized greetings. This Privacy Policy outlines how we collect, use, and protect your personal information while using our app. By downloading, installing, or using Greety, you consent to the practices described in this policy.

Greety is built to work entirely on your device. We do not collect or store your personal information on any server, and there is no account to create.

Information the app uses

Contacts. With your permission, Greety reads the names and birthdays saved in your device's Contacts in order to build your birthday list and personalize greetings. This information is used only on your device. It is never uploaded, transmitted, or shared with us or anyone else.

Notifications. If you allow notifications, Greety schedules birthday reminders locally on your device. These reminders are created and delivered entirely by your device — they do not pass through any server.

Photos. If you choose to set your own greeting card, Greety accesses the image you select so it can be used as your card. The image is stored only on your device.

Where your data is stored

All app data — including contact information, birthdays, and any card you add — is stored locally on your device. Greety has no servers and no online accounts. We have no access to your data.

What we do not do

- We do not collect any personal data.
- We do not use analytics, tracking, or advertising.
- We do not include third-party services that gather your data.
- We do not sell or share your information, because we never receive it.

Sharing greetings

When you send a greeting, Greety hands the message off to another app you already have (such as Messages, WhatsApp, Telegram, or Mail) or to your phone's dialer. From that point on, the message is handled by that app under its own privacy terms. Greety itself does not send anything on your behalf.

Image Playground

On supported devices, you may create a card using Apple's Image Playground feature. This is provided by Apple and operates under Apple's terms; Greety simply uses the result as your card.

Children's privacy

Greety does not collect personal information from anyone, including children.

Permissions

You can review or change Greety's access to Contacts, Notifications, and Photos at any time in your device's Settings. The app's core features rely on Contacts access; without it, the birthday list will be empty.
